#### SUPPORTING ISRAEL

We work hard to get Israel a fair hearing in the media and in Government - a pressing need in times of conflict; and we campaigned to get terrorist groups like Hezbollah, Hamas and Hizb Ut-Tahrir proscribed

Through our school inspection service, Pikuach, we ensure high standards of Jewish education

## LIFECYCLE EVENTS

We defend Jewish interests and respect for Judaism across lifecycle events, defending Shechita, Brit Milah and ensuring Jewish traditions relating to deaths and burials
